**REGULAR MEETING**

**1. Call Regular Meeting to Order and Declare a Quorum.**

Mayor Jack Piper called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM and declared a quorum with the following Aldermen present: Susan Garry, Barbara Piper, and Karen Marosko.

**2. Review and approve minutes of meeting held on October 10, 2019.**

Barbara Piper made a motion to accept the minutes as presented. Susan Garry seconded the motion. The vote to approve the minutes was unanimous.

**3. Financial Reports as of October 31, 2019**

Mayor Piper reported the category for Use Tax-Road Maintenance will use all funds received for road maintenance, as required by law. The City's net worth as of October 31, 2019 was \$219,510.47.

**5. Review and adoption of Resolution 2019-11-14-01 and Ordinance 2019-11-14-01 along with the Interlocal Agreement between Williamson County and the City of Coupland relating to the City's participation in the National Flood Insurance program**

**6. A brief discussion regarding the proposed Nuisance Ordinance.**

The need to approve the ordinance was discussed, especially regarding trash and unsanitary conditions to include the number and condition of vehicles parked in driveways. Plans are to approve a Nuisance Ordinance in January with further discussions necessary.

**7. Discussion concerning road maintenance in the City of Coupland.**

With the recent Williamson County bond passage the City of Coupland will wait for street names sent to the Commissioner to be repaired/replaced when work begins from funds received in this bond issue.

**8. Coupland Volunteer Fire Department activity.**

**9. Coupland citizens/events/announcements/recognitions.**


The Coupland School Board expressed their thanks to the citizens of Coupland for the passage of the recent bond for the Coupland Schools.
