RESOLUTION NO. 2025-09-16-01

A RESOLUTION FOR THE CITY OF COUPLAND, TEXAS, TO ADOPT THE BELOW NAMES FOR THE TWO CURRENTLY GIS NAMED BRUSHY CREEK TRIBUTARIES WHICH FLOW UNDER BRIDGES ON FM1466.

WHEREAS, now that the two bridges on FM 1466, within the city limits of Coupland, Texas, are rebuilt and widened, it is requested the City Council support a resolution to re-name these two Brushy Creek currently GIS named tributaries to more appropriate nomenclature.

WHEREAS, the City Council name the west creek, currently GIS named "Lower Brushy Creek tributary 12", as "Western Creek". The GPS coordinates for the center of the bridge crossing this creek are 30.459193, -97.387336.

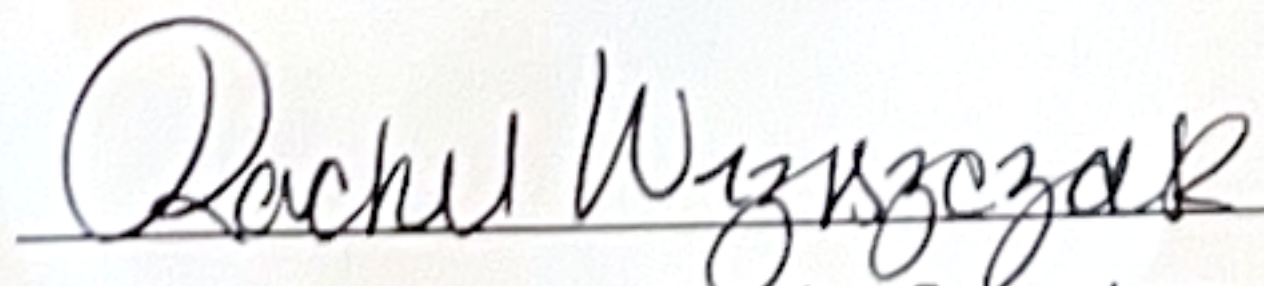
WHEREAS, the City Council name the east creek, currently GIS named "Lower Brushy Creek tributary 12A," as "Eastern Creek". The GPS coordinates for the center of the bridge crossing this creek are 30.459354, -97.382888.

WHEREAS, in so doing, should an extreme rainfall event occur and cause flooding covering the affected bridges, or other catastrophic events such as a car wreck occur involving the bridge crossings, the City of Coupland will be able to identify by specific location as to which bridge(s) is/are effected by a clearly, easily recognized name.

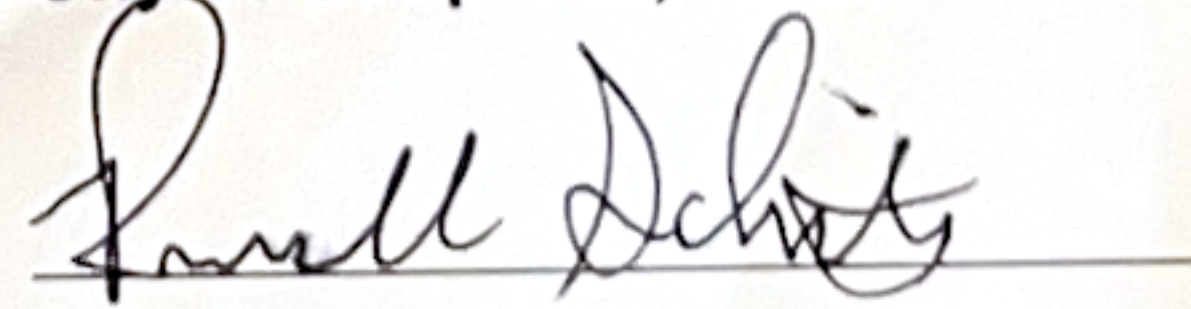
WHEREAS, the said bridges are within the city limits of Coupland, Texas, and FM 1466 is a state roadway, request the Texas Department of Transportation post appropriate, properly marked signs at those bridges on FM 1466.
